

BY-LAW NO. 1602

BEING a By-Law to amend By-Laws #1464 and #1466, By-Laws regulating Traffic on the Public Highways of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend said By-Laws #1464 and #1466.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-Law #1466, Section 1, Clause "I" be repealed and the following substituted therefor.

2. That By-Law #1466, Section 1, be further amended by adding the following Clauses thereto.

T. That all parking be prohibited in areas designated by "Bus Stop" signs or by signs otherwise placed by orders of the Chief Constable and that all such sites so designated whether temporary or permanent be also classed as "No Parking Areas" and parking prohibited.

3. That Clause 11 of By-Law #1464 be amended by adding the following Clause 11A.


11A. That stopping or parking of vehicles on sidewalks be prohibited.

4. That the street name "Klock Ave." wherever and whenever such street name appears throughout By-Law #1464 and By-Law #1466 be deleted and the street name "Algonquin Avenue" substituted therefor.
