

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 13-85

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 110-84, BEING
A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE RENOVATIONS TO THE
HEADQUARTERS FIRE STATION

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to increase the net debentured costs for renovations to the Headquarters Fire Station from \$52,000. to \$67,300.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Clause No. 1 of By-law No. 110-84 be amended by deleting the figure \$52,000. in the second line and inserting in lieu thereof the figure \$67,300 so that Clause No. 1 shall now read as follows:

"That there shall be renovations to the Headquarters Fire Station in the City of North Bay at an estimated cost of Sixty-seven Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$67,300)."
2. That Clause No. 4 of By-law No. 110-84 be amended by deleting the figure \$52,000 in line 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the figure \$67,300 so that Clause No. 4 shall now read as follows:

"The total estimated cost of the work is Sixty-seven Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$67,300) and is to be debentured over a period of fifteen (15) years. The renovation to the Fire Hall shall be as shown on Shedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law."
3. That Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of By-law No. 110-84 be deleted and the Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law be inserted in lieu thereof.
4. That this by-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64(1) of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O., Chapter 347.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF JANUARY 1985.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF JANUARY 1985.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 4TH
DAY OF MARCH 1985.
