

BY-LAW NUMBER 701.

BEING A BY-LAW authorizing the borrowing of the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,000.00).

WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the construction of a sanitary sewer on First Avenue, from Wyld Street to Ferguson Street, in the Town of North Bay, the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) and that is the amount of the debt intended to be created.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the Municipality according to the last Revised Assessment Roll is Six Million, Two Hundred and Fifty-One Thousand, One Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$6,251,190.00).

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Board of Health has ordered that the said sewer be constructed on First Avenue from Wyld Street to Ferguson Street, pursuant to Section 96, of the Provincial Health Act, Revised Statutes of Ontario, Chapter 218.

AND WHEREAS the Order and Approval of the Provincial Board of Health is provided for as follows:-

WE HEREBY report that the Board, having inquired into, ascertained and considered the existing sanitary conditions of the Municipality of the Town of North Bay, is of the opinion that it is necessary in the interests of the public health that owing to the unsatisfactory condition of the sewer on First Avenue from Wyld Street to Ferguson Street that same be reconstructed, in the above Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the Debenture Debt of the Corporation is \$911,231.50, no part of the principal or interest of which is in arrear.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY:-

(1) For the purpose mentioned in the preamble there shall be borrowed on the credit of the Corporation the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) and Debentures shall be issued therefore in sums of not less than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) each, which shall have coupons attached thereto for the payment of the interest.

(2) The Debenture^s shall all bear the same date and shall be issued within two years after the date on which this By-Law is passed and may bear any date within such two years and shall be payable within ten years from the date when they shall be issued and shall bear interest at the rate of Five and One-half per cent per annum, payable yearly in ten annual instalments during the ten years next after the date when they shall be issued, and the respective amounts payable in each of such years shall be as follows:-

(3) The Debentures as to both Principal and interest shall be expressed in Canadian Currency, and shall be payable at the Royal Bank of Canada, North Bay, Ontario.

(4) The Debentures and interest coupons shall be signed and issued by the Mayor, and shall be signed also by the Treasurer, and the Debentures shall be sealed with the Seal of the Corporation.

(5) During the Currency of the Debentures there shall be raised in each year the amount of the instalment of principal and interest payable in that year as set forth in Section Two.

(6) The Debentures may contain any provision for the registration of them authorized by law.

(7) THIS By-Law shall take effect on the day of the passing thereof.

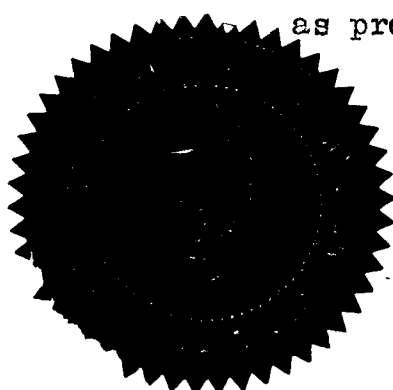
